



New episodic RPG places you in the shoes of Tony Abbott as he seeks to make his political comeback.

Tony Abbott and the Quest for the Suppository of Wisdom is a free episodic role playing game (RPG) that explores the unfortunate state of politics in Australia.

Take control of Australia's favourite* ex-PM, as he seeks to uncover the mysteries of the fabled Suppository of Wisdom and retake his position as captain of Team Australia.

Undermine Malcolm Turnbull, ignore human rights violations and privatise services as you endeavour to bring about a new age of conservative neoliberalism!

Episodes will be released every 6-8 weeks, available free for Mac OS, Windows, iOS and Android devices.

The game is the project of Perth-based musician, writer and activist Ed Smith, and is an effort to depict Australian politics in a way that reflects its absurd detachment from reality. Each episode will incorporate current political drama while also following Tony's personal quest for the Suppository of Wisdom.

This is not, however, just about Tony Abbott. It is about the smug arrogance of a political class who lament about the burden of "the welfare state" while accepting huge donations from destructive industries and favouring legislation to expand their own investment portfolios. It is about the fundamental lack of representation that we experience in our parliament. It is about the exploitation of workers and the sanctioned punishment of the most impoverished in our society. It is about the growing divide between those who own and those who work. And it is also about lampooning those responsible, because if we can't even laugh about it, then we really are fucked.
